The MFJ-132 and MFJ-134 is a uniquely designed timepiece. The MFJ-132 keeps the standard 12-Hour time. The MFJ-134 keeps 24-Hour time.

Battery Replacement and Initialization

The MFJ-132 / MFJ-134 requires two AAA batteries (not included) to operate. Open the battery cover and insert the batteries according to the markings inside the battery compartment. If the LCD Display becomes dim, replace the batteries with new ones.

Setting the Time

In the normal time display, press the SET button (on the back of the unit) one time to bring the unit to time setting mode. The time display will flash (including the “:”). Press the HR and MIN buttons to advance the hour and minute respectively. After setting the time, press the SET button two times to return to the normal time display.

Setting the Alarm Time

In the normal time display, press the SET button two times to go to the alarm setting mode. The time display will flash, but the “:” will not flash. Press the HR and MIN buttons to advance the hour and minute respectively. After setting the alarm, press the SET buttons one time to return to the normal time display.

To activate the alarm, press the HR button in the normal time display mode and the alarm bell will be displayed above the “:” on the time display. The alarm will sound for 1 minute when the current time reaches the alarm time. Press the HR or SET button to stop the alarm. Press the MIN button to activate the snooze function. If the MIN button is pressed, the alarm will sound again after 8 minutes.
